Pastor's Commentary

Update (from my notes):

Twenty two inches of snow on Saturday eve. Church cancelled on Sunday. I skied into the church that morning in the unlikely event that somebody local would try to hoof it, but the snow was too deep even for skis. Wishing I had brought snowshoes. Come Wednesday, our driveway was not plowed out—then I was reminded that we used to tell our snowplow driver to "have us clear by Sunday"—forgetting to tell him that we have a lot more going on midweek than we used to.

That last line made me smile. An active church is a blessed thing. Groups of healing and prayer and song and fellowship abound! Even winter hasn't held back our Community Potluck (though it seems a little silly to call it "Grill's On" anymore).

One witty little aphorism I like to repeat is: "A church with locked doors is like a car without wheels, it just doesn't work!"

...And "work" is what we do. It may not seem like it, most often, as we're laughing and playing and sharing, but think of it this way: every act of love and grace is a little tug on the knot of hopelessness... or loneliness... or anger or despair. Every time we say "you matter" we become participants in that Gospel hope that we see one another through the eyes of God's love, that we shake off our labels or judgment or divisions, and we—by virtue of a smile and kind word—stretch our hands out to share with one another this wild and precious world we live in.

Sure... it's dark out there. The season. The news. Even our neighbors tend to grumble 'round about this time—but see: that's our real work, to be the voice and the reminder that light and love and hope and...well... resurrection!—those are the things that ultimately have the last word in God's hope for us. We won't silence the negativity...it'll always be there... and in respect to own selves we'll stumble and fall, and we'll learn from it all... but using God's gift of this institution of grace, the United Protestant Church will just keep saying: "We see you. We welcome you. We love you. Come in, come in. We are a people of light and warmth." We will light the candles, and bring in the Advent light...

...and I'll be sure to tell the snowplow driver we do more here than just pray together on Sundays.
